

Cruisers coast in 55-over circuit

The Livonia Cruisers don't need Woodward Avenue, because they had their run of the senior men's 55-and-over summer softball circuit.

Managed by Ron Hellier, the former Livonia Adray sandlot and Franklin High baseball coach, the Cruisers brought home a slew of championship hardware and qualified for this week's Senior Softball World Series at Canton Softball Center.

The Cruisers, posting a regular season record of 23-7, captured the Can-Am Senior Softball League's A Division.
