HAPPY ACCIDENTS
Opens exclusively at Star Southfield. TOGETHER
This comedy tells the story of an idealistic hippie commune in mid-1970s Sweden. Stars Lisa Lindgren, Michael Nyquist, Gustav Hammarsten, Anja Lundkvist, Jessica Luedberg, Ola Norell and Shanti Roney.

This comedic drama deals with the struggle for survival for those hiding in German occupied Europe during WWII. Showing exclusively at the Detroit Film Theatre.

HARDBALL
Keanu Reeves stars as Connor, a ticket scalper, gambler and Little League coach for a ragtag team of kids in one of the toughest parts of Chicago. He's no role model, but his buddy Jimmy won't help him pay off his gambling debts unless Connor coaches Jimmy's corporate-sponsored team. Surprising even himself, Connor becomes attached to his players and to their attractive schoolteacher. It's an experience that changes his life while giving his young, streetwise players new hope and pride. Featured players include Diane Lane, John Hawkes and D.B. Sweeney.

KILL ME LATER
A suicidal bank teller agrees to help the escape plan of a thief whose heist has gone wrong, if he agrees to... kill her later. Featured players include Selma Blair, Max Beesley, Brendan Fehr, O'Neal Compton, T.W. Moffet and Lochlyn Munro.

GLITTER
A love story set in 1982, the story tells of Billie Frank, whose drug and alcohol-addicted mother loses custody of her when she's 10 years old. Billie grows up in a foster home in one of the toughest neighborhoods in New York City, where she meets an influential young DJ with whom she pursues her dream of becoming a singer. Featured players include Max Beesley, Ty Tejada, recording artist Eric Benet and singer Mariah Carey.

TRAINING DAY
This movie tracks the events of the first day on the job of a rookie cop (Ethan Hawke) working in the Los Angeles Police Department's undercover narcotics unit. His partner is Alonzo, a corrupt veteran cop (Denzel Washington). Stars Denzel Washington, Ethan Hawke, Tom Berenger, Snoop Dogg, Dr. Dre, Scott Glenn, Macy Gray, Charlotte Ayanna, Raymond J. Barry, Sarah Madison, Eva Mendes, Will Foster Stewart and Harris Yulin.

THE VERTICAL RAY OF THE SUN
The story takes place over the course of a month and deals with the close relationship of three sisters, each keeping her own dark and paralyzing secret. Showing exclusively at the Detroit Film Theatre.

BIG TROUBLE
Based on the novel by Pulitzer Prize-winning newspaper columnist Dave Barry, the story tells of how a mysterious suitcase brings together - and changes - the lives of a divorced dad, an unhappy housewife, two hit men, a pair of street thugs, two lovestruck teens, two FBI men and a psychotic loner. Featured among the ensemble are Rene Russo, Stanley Tucci, Tom Sizemore, Johnny Knoxville, Jason Lee and Tim Allen as Eliot, the dead man who tries to save the day.

HALLOWEEN: THE HOMEcoming
A group of six teenagers stage a live Internet chat from the house Michael Myers grew up in, and, sure enough, the soon shows up to do some nostalgic slicing and dicing. Featured players include Jamie Lee Curtis, Tyra Banks, Brad Loree, Busta Rhymes and Sean Patrick Thomas. Rick Rosenthal helms the thriller.

LIAM
Set in Liverpool's Irish Catholic community, the story centers on a working-class family during the Depression as seen through the eyes of a 7-year-old, Liam, a young schoolboy, struggles with his family's poverty and his stuttering impediment, a quick attribution to his sinful nature. Featured players include Ian Hart, Claire Hackett, Anne Reid and newcomer Anthony Borrows as Liam, a boy who struggles to define himself in a hostile world. Stephen Frears directs the drama, marking his first since completing *High Fidelity* in 2000.

SIDEWALKS OF NEW YORK
Billed as a romantic comedy, the story centers on interwoven love stories set in New York. Featured among the ensemble are Edward Burns, Heather Graham, Stanley Tucci, Brittany Murphy, Rosario Dawson and David Krumholtz. Directed by Edward Burns.

DON'T SAY A WORD
Michael Douglas stars as Dr. Nathan Conrad, a respected New York City psychiatrist who races to secure the freedom of his kidnapped daughter but must first retrieve a critical piece of information from his newest but bono patient, a catatonic-violent but angelic-looking 18-year-old girl. Featured players include Oliver Platt, Famke Janssen, Brittany Murphy and Sean Bean as the villain after the hidden treasure from an old heir.

OUR LADY OF THE ASSASSINS
From the 1994 novel by Fernando Vallejo, the film tells of a middle-aged gay writer who returns to his hometown and unexpectedly falls in love with a homicidal young gang member. Showing exclusively at the Detroit Film Theatre.

HEARTS IN ATLANTIS
Set in Hawick, Conn., in 1960, this is the story of Bobby Garfield, a fatherless 11-year-old boy who is befriended by Ted Brauligan, a man who boards in the building where Bobby lives with his mother. Stars Anthony Hopkins, Anton Yelchin and Hope Davis.

ZOOGLANDER
The story focuses around the world's most famous and empty-headed male model Derek Zoolander, a character Ben Stiller created for the VH1 Fashion Awards three years ago. As the action unfolds, this blank-faced stack-jawed, self-obsessed male supermodel finds himself in an international fashion adventure. Featured players include Owen Wilson, Will Ferrell, Julie Jovovich and Jerry Stiller. Ben Stiller helms the comedy.

COLLATERAL DAMAGE
The action follows a family man (Arnold Schwarzenegger) who is plunged into the complex and dangerous world of international terrorism after he loses his

wife and child in a bombing. Frustrated with the official investigation and haunted by the thought that the man responsible for murdering his family might never be brought to justice, he takes matters into his own hands and tracks his quarry, ultimately to Colombia. Featured players include Elias Koteas, Francesca Neri and Cliff Curtis.

GRATEFUL DAWD
An inside look at two musical powerhouses, Grateful Dead guitarist Jerry Garcia and mandolinist David Grisman, showcasing their musical magic through rare concert footage, unreleased audio tracks and living room jam sessions. Gillian Griesman, David Griesman's daughter, directs the documentary.

JOY RIDE
The story centers on a college freshman who embarks on a cross-country trip to pick up the girl of his dreams. The trip takes a turn for the worse when he stops on the way to rescue his troubled older brother, who goes into playing a practical joke on a lonely trucker over the CB radio. Trouble ensues when the trucker wants revenge and becomes their worst nightmare. Featured players include Steve Zahn, Paul Walker, Leelee Sobieski and Matthew Kimbrough.

MAX KEEBLE'S BIG MOVE
After a depressing first day of school, much-bullied seventh grader Max Keeble finds out that he's moving to a new city

in a week. Rather than put up with the normal routine of school, he starts getting revenge on all the people who have picked on him. After creating all kinds of mayhem, Max must face up to the consequences of his actions. Stars Alex D. Linz, Clifton Davis and Amy Hill.

SERENOPITY
The story centers on Jonathan and Sara, who met one magical night when they were in their twenties. He was in love at first sight, but Sara believed in destiny. Now, after 10 years, two fiancées, and 3,000 miles between them, only fate can decide whether they're destined to be together again. Featured players include John Cusack, Kate Beckinsale, John Corbett and Jeremy Piven.

BANDITS
The story tells of the suave, irresistible Joe (Bruce Willis) and his hypochondriac partner (Billy Bob Thornton), who have escaped from prison. Cutting a swath from Oregon through California, these fugitives rob banks in order to finance their scheme for a new - and somewhat legitimate - life south of the border. In their wake, they leave a trail of chaos, disguises, wrecked automobiles, and an adoring public. Their operation is running smoothly until an unexpected run-in with Kate (Cate Blanchett), who is drawn to the thieves as a way to escape her ordinary life. Together Joe and Tony are the most successful bank robbers in U.S. history.

CORBY ROMANO
Good-natured veterinarian Corby Romano (Chris Kattan) is stunned when he receives a surprising call from his long-lost father, Pops (Peter Falk), an underworld crime lord who has been indicted by a grand jury. With his trial just two weeks away, it looks as if the Mafia kingpin is finally going down. Pops realizes that the one person who can turn the tables and infiltrate the FBI undetected and abscond with the evidence against him is Corby. Under the guise of Agent Pissent, Corby stumbles into the halls of justice and tries to take his way through tough assignments while hunting for the elusive incriminating proof of Pops' illegal activities.

THE LAST CASTLE
The story revolves around a wrongfully convicted five-star general (Robert Redford) who is sent to a maximum-security prison known as the Castle. The general turns the inmates into his own army and threatens to take over the prison. Featured players include Mako Ruffalo, Clifton Collins Jr., and James Gandolfini as the warden who once served under the general's command.
