Anger and Sin

The Bible tells us that we should not let our anger become sin, because the wages of sin are death. As humans, we have many different emotions, and how we handle these emotions determines, in part, what kind of person we are. Everyone enjoys being around someone who is loving, kind and pleasant. We usually try to avoid people who are rude, inconsiderate or ill-tempered. Most everyone will get angry at one time or another, but when our anger is out of control, we usually do not act as God would want. Controlling our anger can sometimes be helpful in correcting certain situations, and may help us avoid harming others by our actions or words. When children misbehave, they may cause a parent to become angry. The way in which parents handle those situations can serve to be an important learning experience for the child. Our Heavenly Father wants us to be an example of his love, and being slow to anger and full of compassion for those around us reflects God's love.

If you become angry, do not let your anger lead you into sin, and do not stay angry of day.
