exhibit Thursday, Sept. 20: Multicultural/multiracial community council kick off rally at 7 p.m.

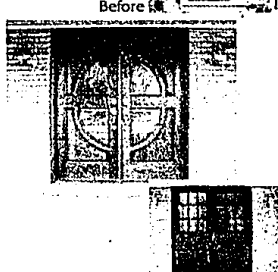
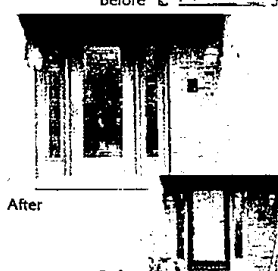
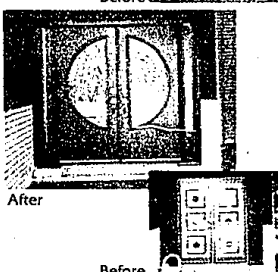
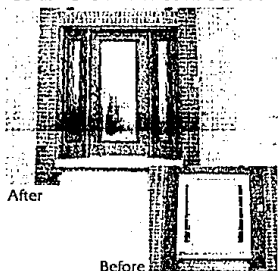
