

North's Barrows top runner in Rice cross country invite

North Farmington's Susan Barrows was the individual winner Saturday in the Division 1 girls race of the Brother Rice Invitational at Kensington Metropark.

Barrows captured first place with a 19:45 time. North's Nicole

Moundros was ninth (21:01) and Katie Milan 31st (22:28). The top 35 received medals.

"(Barrows) looked good throughout the race," coach Bill Pinnell said. "She had a lead before the mile mark and kept increasing it. She looked strong;

it didn't look like she was struggling at all." Kristian Stamboulis finished 43rd (23:08) for the Raiders, Anne Lieberman 61st (23:16), Shara Cherniak 82nd (24:38) and Liz Murrenus 117th (26:20). Competing against 22 other

teams in the smaller-school division, the North girls finished fifth in the team standings. Schools with larger enrollments were in Division 2.

Just 19 points separated the top five teams. Sault Ste. Marie won the meet with 116; Trenton

had 122, Portage Northern 123, Grasse Ile 128 and North Farmington 135. Jackson Lumen Christi was sixth (214) and Farmington Harrison 15th (356).

"I was pretty pleased with the performance of the team," Pinnell said. "The goal was to finish

in the top five. The girls knew what they had to do; they did a good job."

Shamrocks take 3rd place

For having an inexperienced team, Catholic Central fared pretty well at the Brother Rice Invitational on Saturday, coming away with a third-place finish at the 27-team meet.

"I was pleasantly surprised," CC coach Tony Magni said. "I figured if we ran OK, we could be in the top five. Some of our kids really stepped up. We only had one returnee from last year and five of our seven kids had never run varsity before."

Grand Lodge won the meet with 141 points, with Portage Northern coming in third with 143. CC had 166, Livonia Churchill followed with 180, Livonia Stevenson was seventh with 256 and Plymouth Salem was 15th with 357.

Ryan Lowry led the Shamrocks by coming in third in 16:34. David Lucas was 23rd in 17:09, Kyle Jekot was 27th in 17:23, Dan Horgan was 52nd in 18:02 and Bryan Seymour was 61st in 18:09.

"Horgan and Lucas are both sophomores and ran pretty well," said Magni. "You get in a race with over 150 runners, it can be intimidating but we held our own. Now we have to get our third through sixth runners closer to the top with our kids. That's our goal Saturday at Holly."


