

Hawks extend winning streak to 3 dual meets in row

Laura Uridge and Ellen Doughty led the way Tuesday night as Farmington Harrison won its third straight league dual meet in girls swimming.

The Hawks are 3-0 in the Western Lakes Activities Association after defeating Westland John Glenn, 116-69. Harrison's only loss was to West Bloomfield

in the season opener.

Uridge and Doughty won two individual events each and assisted in two relay victories. The meet ended with Katie Steff and Jackie Waldecker teaming with Uridge and Doughty to win the 400-yard freestyle relay (4:10.91).

Doughty anchored the winning medley relay team, which included Katie Riley, Waldecker and Steff and posted a 2:04.18 time.

Uridge was the lead swimmer on the first-place 200 freestyle relay team, combining with Danielle Liebowitz, Steff and Margaret White to finish in 1:57.72.

Doughty had victories in the 50 freestyle (27.57) and the 100 (1:00.03). Uridge won the 200 freestyle (2:12.44) and the butterfly (2:10.57).

Steff was the winner in the 500 freestyle (5:29.67). Riley the backstroke (1:11.05) and Waldecker the breaststroke (1:14.34). Glenn won the IM and diving.

"Overall, we swam well," Harrison coach Ross Bandy said. "A lot of younger kids got to swim more events and pick up points

toward their letters. A lot of parents got to see their kids swim.

"It was enjoyable; the team had a lot of fun. We're just really happy with our performance, and we're looking forward to next week."

NOTICE OF THE LAST DAY FOR RECEIVING REGISTRATIONS FOR THE GENERAL NOVEMBER ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF FARMINGTON ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2001

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the City of Farmington, County of Oakland, Michigan, who is not already registered to vote may register for the general November election to be held on the 6th day of November, 2001, in the City of Farmington.

Act 116, Public Acts of Michigan, 1954; as amended, provides in part as follows:

"The inspectors of election at any election or primary election in this state, or in any district, county, township, city or village thereof, shall not receive the vote of any person whose name is not registered in the registration book of the township, ward or precinct in which he offers to vote.

Under the provisions of Act 116, Public Acts of Michigan, 1954, as amended, only persons who have registered as general electors with the appropriate Clerk of the City or Township in which they reside, or through registration at a Secretary of State drivers license bureau, or otherwise as permitted by law, are registered electors.

The City Clerk will be at the Clerk's office in the City Hall on each working day during regular working hours until and including Tuesday, October 9, 2001, for the purpose of receiving registrations of qualified electors of the City of Farmington not already registered.

On Tuesday, October 9, 2001, which is the last day for receiving registrations for the general November election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2001, the City Clerk will be at the Clerk's office between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., prevailing Eastern Time, for the purpose of receiving registrations of qualified electors.

The following proposition will be submitted to the electors of the City of Farmington at the election:

Sewage Disposal System Bonding Proposition


Shall the City of Farmington, County of Oakland, Michigan, borrow the principal sum of not to exceed One Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000), payable in not to exceed 20 years from the date of issue, and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds for the purpose of paying all or a part of the cost of acquiring and constructing improvements to the City's sewage disposal system consisting generally of rehabilitation of the primary sewer interceptor pipe that connects Farmington to the Detroit Wastewater Treatment System by inserting a liner inside the current pipe together with all appurtenances and attachments reasonably necessary thereof? The estimated millage to be levied in 2002 is .34 mills (\$34 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and the estimated simple average annual millage rate required to retire the bonds is .34 mills (\$34 per \$1,000 of taxable value).
