Wine storage units fit in many rooms today

Wine cabinets have come out of the cellar.

Today's wine enthusiasts can store wine in units that are attractive and functional, sophisticated in both appearance and technology.

A customer can select a unit in the Sub-Zero 400 Series in wood or stainless steel. The metal shelves are rustproof and have wood facing. Some units include a shelf that tilts slightly toward the front so bottles can be displayed.

"(A unit) can be totally integrated in cabinetry, or under a counter," said Ginger Trevarrow, at the Trevarrow showroom in Auburn Hills.

The storage pieces are at home in a kitchen, bar area, recreation room, walk-through entertainment area or butler's pantry.

The series features humidity control - to prevent corks from drying out - ultraviolet-resistant glass doors and a service alert indicator. Doors also come in a solid style. The units can tie in to the security system of a residence.

Each unit has two separate temperature zones that can be set between 38 and 65 degrees Fahrenheit. Wine that is being prepared for serving that day can be kept in one section while other wines can be kept in a different section for long-term storage.

The smallest model in Sub-Zero's series is the five-shelf, under the counter unit that holds 46 bottles. The largest model stores a total 147 bottles on 14 shelves.

In between are a 14-shelf unit that holds 132 bottles, and a model that features a two-drawer base for additional food and beverage storage. The latter holds 78 bottles and has a display shelf for six bottles.

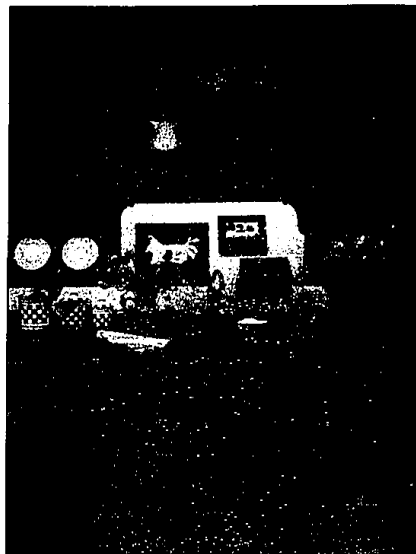

Suggested retail prices range from \$1,900 to \$4,500.

Kenmore offers a 2.6 cubic foot wine storage model - 26 inches high and 18-5/8 inches wide - that fits quarter- and half-barrel kegs. The unit is priced at \$245.

"It's self-defrost. There's no freezer at all," said Larry Grace,

refrigeration specialist at Sears at Oakland Mall in Troy. "It's insulated well."

Wine storage units to be built into walls can be special ordered through KitchenAid, Grace said. Features include canted wine racks to hold 60 bottles. The cost is around \$600.
