But the one who proclaims God's message speaks to people and gives them help, encouragement, and comfort.

Good News Bible
1 Corinthians 14:3

If you are like most people, there are times when you doubt your own abilities and self-worth. We are often our own worst enemy as well as our own harshest critic. When we are being overly critical or are generally taking a negative view of ourselves, it helps to remember the praise and encouragement that we have received from others. Former teachers, family members and friends have probably told you in a variety of ways that you are a competent and good person, and that they enjoy your company. When you are feeling down about yourself, give someone a call who is likely to validate you in a positive way.
