Eric Lynn, Matt Showalter, Ben Dziale and Jeff Nevi (3:51.25), and the 400 freestyle relay, with Mike Johnson, Mike Horgan, William Clark and Nick Dixon (3:31.41).

Things seemed to even out over the next five events, but Salem owned the final three, finishing first in all of them.

Jim Franks, Clark, Dixon and Dziale won the 500 free relay (4:34.42); Nick Yes, Casey Johnson, Lynn and Johnson were first in the 200 medley relay (1:46.32); and Danny Daniels, Kevin Kilgore, Matt Vivian and Matt Poniatowski took top honors in the 200 free relay (1:40.37).

Although the Chiefs managed only one first-place finish, they were obviously in great shape with seven seconds.
