

Sladek Favors Part-time Role On County Board

Republican candidate for county supervisor, Hank Sladek said today he favored part-time county supervisors.

"Some candidates are considering the idea that the county supervisor's post should be full time, and I strongly oppose this view," Sladek said.

By act of the State Legis-

lature, the cumbersome county boards have been reorganized on the "one-man-one-vote" principle. Wayne County's Board of 135 was reduced to 26 by a committee appointed to propose how the county would reorganize.

Sladek said that supervisors will have the right to establish

their salary during their first term of office.

"I'm concerned that a movement might develop to justify making this a full time job, because of the latitude given the new board on salary," he added.

Sladek said sometime in the future circumstances might

warrant making it a full time job.

The present board recently approved a \$3,500 annual salary, but Sladek points out that their action is not binding.

"A sounder method could have been devised for setting these initial salaries, such as the State Legislature setting salary guidelines."

Candidate Sladek said that there are "far more important" matters than salary.

"The very first order of business for the new county board is the crucial item of organizing ourselves as a unit of government capable of serving the county."

Auction Of Gas, Oil Rights

A recent wildcat strike in Presque Isle County has set the stage for the largest lease sale of state oil and gas rights ever offered by the Michigan Department of Conservation.

The public auction is scheduled for August 5 in Lansing's Civic Center and will involve state oil and gas rights covering about 583,300 acres in 24 counties of the northern Lower Peninsula.

The Department's biggest previous oil and gas lease sale took place in 1962 when some 433,200 acres were put up for bidding. It resulted in 234,815 acres being leased and brought bid receipts to the State totaling a record \$310,812.

Biggest lease offerings to be made in August will include nearly 100,000 acres in Cheboygan County, 88,500 acres in Missaukee County, 79,000 acres in Presque Isle County, and 75,515 acres in Otsego County.
