said.
"Most of our population has never been on a train now," he said, adding he will show timetables for just one of Detroit's three rail stations, showing the number of trains coming and going.

Keeping the engines moving was just part of the railway picture. Borses said he had been a fireman for 10 years before he ever set foot in any of the 'back shops,' where engines and care were maintained. Every piece had to be stripped down and inspected to make sure the engines were in running order. "It was a huge complex, I stood there, and I was in awe," he said. You have no idea what It takes to keep these things running." Shoveling coal was quite a job—he'd have to move about six tons in an eight-hour day, for a salary of \$7.43. 
