TOO BUSY TO PRAY?

The Bible tells us that whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you will receive it and you will. And, whenever you stand praying, forgive if you have anything against anyone so that your Father, who is in heaven, also may forgive you for your trespasses (Mark 11:24, 25). Sometimes we expect God to ignore us all of our worldly desires, even when we seem to be too busy to go to Him in prayer.
