Students in Salciccioli's 2nd hour class took a hard line on whether Andrea Yates, a Texas mother recently convicted of killing her five children, should have gotten a death sentence, rather than life in prison. Although she'd been diagnosed with a mental illness, most felt she should have been executed.

"Just because you're crazy doesn't mean you can kill people and get away with it," said 13-year-old Jeremy Spriggs.

Toy then pushed the issue of capital punishment a step further, asking how they felt about imprisoned Dr. Jack Kervorkian, who has admitted helping others end their lives. The consensus appeared to be that was different, because the "victim" wanted to die anyway.
