years ago. Now it's norm.

"My silent gesture has a loud voice," she said. "We are part of a

universe that is awakening. We are the ones who make a difference. Our lives are a white canvas. Every day I ask myself, 'how am I going to make a difference?' We are small but we can do big things." Hatch Musica Viva concert is like a microcosm of the world, she says. This concert will showcase music from three continents and 10 countries – from the mysteries of African drums, to the luscious melodies of China, and Latin American tango.

Ortega heard Binkuye in Ann Arbor and was very impressed with the group's authenticity. One of its members, Mark Stone, is a scholar who has studied west African music.

What I am trying to do is create new sounds and instrumentation," said Ortega as she explained the music of Groupo Musica Viva. "This kind of combination of instruments is very rare, therefore you hear a new kind of sound with a classical base, but a new twist that explores different colors of the instrumentation. We are exploring the music of Latin America and taking it to another level."


