It was a local social organization that heard her prayer for a way out of her house.

Oakland Livingston Human Service Agency, headquartered in Ponties and serving throughout the two counties, included Hutchinson's home in its pilot program of five ramps. Jerry Sedick, OLHSA's associate director, said the need for this service is "overwhelming."

wheelchair ramps. Among them are Wright & Filippis, Inc. of Rochester Hills, and Caring Solutions, of Farmington Hills.

A.J. Filippis, CEO of his company, said cost of an average ramp without complicated turns is about \$3-4,000.

His company generally uses treated wood for permanent installations. Temporary ramps are priced at a fixed fee for installation and removal and a minimum of three-months rontal, totaling about \$1,700-\$2,200.

Filippis points out that city building permits are required and various state regulations must be followed. Do-it-your selfers ought to know that every inch of riso necessitates 12 inches of ramp; every 30

feet of ramp require a resting platform. Railing spindles must be on a maximum of 4-inch centers to prevent child head outcomment.

At Caring Solutions, executive assistant Janet Parker said her company likes to build the ramp at the rear of the house whenever possible, for appearance and security. When the ramp must be at the front of the house, "We try to integrate landscaping to reduce the harshness of the appearance." She said her company even has built rampinside attached garages. Her company's average ramps, she company's average ramps, she said, can be in the \$2-5,000

Both companies say that under certain conditions, some insurance plans can help with the cost of the ramp.


