Four difference players scored Thursday as Livonia Ladywood clinched third place in the Catholic League by defeating host Farmington Hills Mercy, 4-0.

Ladywood, 6-3-4 overall and 4-3-3 in the league, squares off against defending Catholic League champion and second seed Madison Heights Bishop Foley. Ladywood is 0-1-1 against the Ventures, the defending Division II state champion.
