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Bad weather spoils Mid-Michigan opener

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Opening-game problems were anticipated, considering a rebuilt team with a new coach that had practiced together about 10 days playing their first match on the road.

One additional problem the Mid-Michigan Bucks didn't need was the weather.

In their Premier Development League Great Lakes Division season-opener Saturday at the Indiana Invaders, the Bucks didn't generate the kind of offense they thought they would, which led to a 1-1 draw. The game was stopped by inclement weather after 70 minutes.

"This hurts both teams, really," said Bucks' general manager Jim Duggan. "It's the worst thing that can happen to both of us. It puts us in a bad spot."

The reason: The first four matches of the season also count as U.S. Cup qualifiers. A win earns four points, a score more than three goals in a match and that's an additional point. A draw is worth one point for each squad.

The Bucks scored first, three minutes into the second half. The Scicluna (from Redford/Country Day HS) fed the ball to Pat Noonan in the box and Noonan cut back, curling his shot into the left corner to make it 1-0. The Invaders knotted it in the 65th minute, Fedrico Puaez

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scoring on a deflection following his free kick. Bucks' keeper Eric Pogue had no chance on the play.

"We looked very disorganized in the midfield," said Duggan. "And that's somewhat expected in the first game. The effort was certainly there, the guys just need more time together. We could have used that extra 20 minutes on Saturday."

"(The Invaders) are a good team, but I thought we made them look better than they are. We would have been on the attack a whole lot more (in the midfield)."

The Bucks played the West Michigan Edge in Holland last night. They have their home-opener at 7:30 p.m. Saturday at Birmingham Seaholm HS. Tickets purchased at the gate are \$9 for adults and \$6 for students, or call the Bucks at (734) 483-GOAL.
