

Mets select MSU's Malek in 4th

Major League Baseball held its annual amateur draft starting Tuesday, and a handful of Observerland area players were selected.

Redford Catholic Central graduate Bobby Malek was picked by the New York Mets in the fourth round of the draft, 117th overall, the highest slot any Michigan player was picked.

Malek, a junior at Michigan State, was recently selected as the tri-Big Ten Player of the Year, though he remained open about returning to East Lansing

for a fourth season with the Spartans. As of last week, he had not signed with an agent.

Malek graduated from CC in 1999, helping the team to its first Division I state championship.

The MLB scouting service compared Malek to St. Louis Cardinals star J.D. Drew with his powerful upper body and quick bat.

Another CC grad, David

Vinno, was selected by the Seattle Mariners with the 610th pick in the draft. He was a senior for Oakland University this season, and was drafted as a right-handed pitcher. He stands 6-foot-1 and weighs in at 216 pounds.

Other area players who were not drafted as of Tuesday night, but were considered draftable players, included: Ryan Rogowski (Redford CC), Drew Stanton (Farmington Harrison) and Anthony Toney (Eastern Michigan, Redford CC).
