## Girls say man exposed self

Farmington Hills Police released a composite sketch of a man believed to be involved in an indecent exposure case in the city. According to police, a 10-year-old girl was walking home from Brandywine School along Brandywine just north of Old Forge around 2:20 p.m. May 30 when a vehicle slowly approached her and came within 10 feet. The driver had his window open and the seat back so he could raise his pelvis and expose his penis. The girl stated the man just laughed and drove off, but then made a second pass in the same direction and exposed himself again. He continued northbound and out of sight. The case is not believed related to the several accosting cases in February involving a man and young girls while he drove a dark Ford Explorer. The man in the latest incident is described driving an older model car, possibly a four-door maroon Ford Taurus with a gray interior. The man is described as between 18-25 years, 5-feet, 6 inches to 5-feet, 10 inches tall, medium weight, short brown hair, light complexion, wearing rectangular, dark metal frame glasses and wearing a mostly yellow polo shirt with blue and white horizontal stripes with a white collar and khaki shorts.
