onemicals do have a place in the world, but not in the house, on skin or on pets," she said. Chemicals do have a place

citrus oil. For mold, white vinegar mixed with 12 drops of essential oil and water. To freshen carpet and kill germs, mix baking soda with a few drops of sweet orange, pepper-mint or lime and vacuum after 15 minutes. Or use cornstarch.

Keep windows clean with white vinegar, which is highly antiseptic; infuse it with 15 drops of lavender oil and 1 cup

antiseptic; infuse it with and drops of lavender oil and I cup of water.

"To keep the flow positive mix lavender petals with cedar chips," Boyadian said. "It's a good mothball concection and adds a nice seent in the air."

Ammonia may cut grease, but it can also strip wax from floors. Instead, use baking soda. Blench may whiten practically anything but it's a toxin; Borax is a blench alternative and boosts the cleaning ability of soap. Ketchup cleans copper, salt is a gentle abrasive for cleaning pans; and olive oil is a decent furniture polish (test it in a safe area of the wood first).

As important as natural cleaning products are in the home, so is the idea of natural scents. Boyajian said that citrus oils can energize and uplift; so can peppermint and ginger. The Good Home Co.


