ORDINARY OR EXTRAORDINARY?
The Bible is full of people who considered themselves too ordinary to perform God's extraordinary work. Recall how Moses complained to God that he was not eloquent enough to speak on Israel's behalf to Pharaoh (Exodus 4:10), or how Saul could not believe that he was called to be a prophet (1 Samuel 9:10). Even today our families and friends sometimes reinforce our lack of confidence, as they did in Saul's case, asking "What has come over the son of Kish? Is Saul also among the prophets?" (1 Samuel 10:11) Sometimes those who know and love us best are also our severest critics and the ones least likely to encourage us to try great things. However, we are usually our own worst enemies in this regard, often refusing to believe that we can do great things, or being hesitant to even try, perhaps due to a fear of failure. All great things start with these first small steps. For example, writing just a page a day will produce a book-length work in less than a year; reading a few articles every week in your chosen field will slowly but surely make you an expert; and doing small acts of kindness every day will help to endear you to family and friends. Advance confidently in the direction of your dreams, knowing that you will get there if you just keep at it long enough.
