three, including a doubleheader Sunday at Chief Pontiac, and is 1-3 heading into a Friday game with Rochester.

Tony Luttman pitched a complete game against Milford, scattering four hits and walking five.

Farmington took a 2-0 lead in the first inning with an RBI double by Bob Houchins and an RBI groundout by Preston Picard.

Post 346 doubled its lead in the second. Anthony Volpe doubled and scored on a wild pitch, and Ryan Baranik scored on a double steal after Chris Chesney had walked.

Ian Pardonnet had an RBI single for a 5-2 lead, and he hit a three-run homer to make it 8-2 in the fifth inning.

Berkley had solo homers in the fifth and sixth innings Friday to defeat Farmington, 6-5. Houchins relieved starter Joe James in the fourth and got the loss.

Post 346 had four hits and was led by Volpe, who was 3-for-3. Jake Ghannam, Luttman and James had one RBI each.

Farmington had a 1-0 lead Sunday in the first game against Chief Pontiac, which scored twice in the bottom of the fourth on a single and three errors. The host team added another run for a 3-1 victory. Luttman pitched another complete game, again throwing a four-hitter, striking out seven and walking four.

Post 346 lost the nightcap, 4-2. Luttman hit a two-run single to tie the score, 2-2. Micah Demyer allowed just one hit in two innings of relief but took the loss.

Farmington plays host to Rochester at 6:30 p.m. Friday at Farmington High. Post 346 will be at home Sunday for a noon doubleheader with Clarkston.
