

# Man arrested for trying to crash FHS all-night party

Farmington Public Safety officers arrested and ticketed a Northville man just after midnight June 10 for trespassing during the senior all-night graduation party at Farmington High School.

The 18-year-old man, a drop-out, lives within the school district boundaries, police said.

A person working security at the event noticed that the man was wearing a parent supervisor badge. He told the man to leave because he wasn't a graduate or a parent.

The man went outside for awhile but returned into the school, located on Shiawassee, pushing his way past the person working security and throwing \$40 down on the floor. That was the admission fee, police said.

Police who arrived put him in

a "come-along hold" and arrested him, leading him out of the school.
