Show features locals who claim to be alien abductees

The first time aliens visited Landi Mellas, she was 7 years

Landi Mellas, she was 7 years old.

My first consciously recalled experience was in 1951, 5 aid threttired executive secretary and grandmother of 12. 1 was awakened in the middle of the night and felt compelled to go downstairs. On my porch stood non-terrestrial beings.

Mellas' experiences grew stranger as she grew older.

"When I was 14, something unsettling happened. I found myself upstairs in my bedroom and heard a horrible piercing noise coming from downstairs, she said.

Mellas said the noise rever-

Mellas said the noise rever-berated through the house.

"I found my 60-pound dog plastered against the front door like she was paralyzed," she said.
"I inched my way to the kitchen and I found the kitchen floor

I inched tay way to the Ritchen and I found the Ritchen floor bouncing up and down in a perfect circle of gynnting molecules. I stuck my leg in the circle of energy to make sure I wasn't hallucinating. My leg started shaking, like the molecules were coming apart.

Mellas, who now lives in Highland, is one of three Michigan residents who talk about their experiences with alien visitors on the Sci-Fi Channel documentary. Adduction Diaries. The series, airing Dec. 8 and 1s, explores first-person accounts of individuals who have had encounters with renatures they believe are alien visitors.

with creatures they believe are alien visitors. The documentaries accompany Stephen Spielberg's 10-episode miniseries Taken, which premieres 14 9 µm. Monday, Dec. 2, on the Sci-Fi Channel. Taken is a fictionalized account of three families encounters with UFOs and alien abductions from the 1940s to the present

to the present.

Clawson resident Bill Chaff, who also appears in Abduction Diaries, said he has had contacts with visitors since he was 2 years old.

"I've had 30 years of experi-ences; I've had about 75, as a best guess," he said. Chaff described a typical

experience.
I went to sleep and awoke several feet above my bed, float-ing," he said. "When I tried to move, I found I was paralyzed and had a tingling feeling

throughout my body." Chaff saw what he described

ss a "gray being" at the foot of his bed and two more in the hallway. The one at the foot of mis bed and two more in the hallway. The one at the foot of my bed apoke tele-pathically in my mind. It was very deep, bass and powerful, sort of a beckoning. At that point, I decided to fight the sensation," he said. My vision blacked out and then I was back in bed, with the paralysis and the tingling and the beings gone. Chaff offers a possible theory about the alien visitors: They are explorers investigating life on Earth.

"We have people like Diane Fossey and Jane Goodall working with goriflas and chimpanzees," he said. "Although that may be an insulting concept, they (the nliens) look at us like kin, but not necessarily as equals."

Chaff's experiences led him to join the Mutual Unidentified Flying Object Network, (MUFON) the largest civilian UFO research organization in the U.S. Chaff said many of the UFOs he has investigated for MUFON had a more pedestrian evaluation.

explanation. "One was fireworks, one was a blimp, one was Venus or another celestial object," he another celestial object," he said. Tm investigating an object seen in Troy, that was cube-like in shape and glowing a pale blue in its entirety. It was said to have crossed over 1-75 right around the Big Beaver exit. No other reports were turned or

right arouted the sign desired sett. No other reports were turned up. Chaff said researchers are looking into the possibility the object was a blimp. "It wouldn't be the first time. The case is still under review." Chaff said a psychologist approached him about appearing on the Abduction Diaries. "I have several friends who are professional psychologists who deal with individuals who have this type of experience," he said. "I'm often tapped to help people who are having difficulties going through this." David Caywood, a research assistant at Wayne State University, said his story will be featured on the Abduction Diaries ther this summer.

Diaries later this summer. Caywood and Mellas ha

written a book about their experiences with alien visitors. It's called *The Other Sky*, published by Blue Star Productions.

Caywood claims a number of alien species exist.

There are many who look like us. They are from different stars and different dimensions.
