Ford car and truck sales continued at a bot pace during the first 10 days of Novamber following Ford Division's record October sales and the most successful new product introduction in history.


Sales of 42,908 cars and 15,-233 trucks brought the division's combined year-to-date total to 2,174,373 units, the second biggest year-to-date total in history.




