

Board Eases Policy

LANSING -- Michigan non-high school graduates will find it easier to obtain high school diplomas or their equivalent through action taken by the State Board of Education.

The board approved standards for the issuance of diplomas or high school equivalency certificates to non-graduates on the basis of written examination results. The certificates can also be awarded by the Michigan Department of Education and the board recommended the credits toward a diploma for courses taken during military service be recognized.

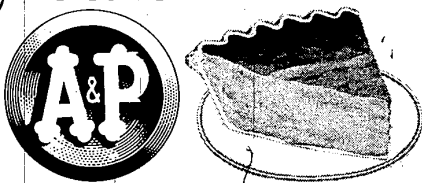
"THE NEW POLICY standards will open the doors of employment to many able non-graduates denied job opportunities because they lack a diploma," said Board President Edwin L. Novak.

"It will also be a special boon to returning servicemen who have earned education credits through armed forces courses if the schools will apply them toward a diploma, as recommended."

The test, a battery of five subject-matter examinations known as the General Education Development (GED) Test, is used by all but a few states for equivalency certificates, issued either by the state education agency or local schools. It is prepared and passing grades established for nationwide usage by the American Council of Education. Minimum passing scores are set at a point where 20 per cent of high school seniors taking the same examination fail, thereby assuring a valid measurement of equivalent academic attainment.

Test results and the equivalency certificate have long been recognized by government, the armed forces and a number of industries in lieu of a bona fide diploma.

ITALIAN FRIED CHICKEN

Fryer, in pieces
1/2 cup flour
2 tablespoons grated Romano cheese
2 teaspoons paprika
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon black pepper
1/2 teaspoon oregano
1/2 teaspoon rosemary
1/2 teaspoon crushed red pepper

Combine dry ingredients in a paper bag. Add 2 or 3 pieces of chicken at a time, and shake to coat. Brown in 1/4 cup oil and 3 tablespoons butter. Arrange in single layer, skin side up, in a baking dish. Pour over pan drippings. Bake in 375-degree oven for 1 hour, or until done, basting with drippings every 15 minutes. Must be prepared ahead except for final oven baking.
