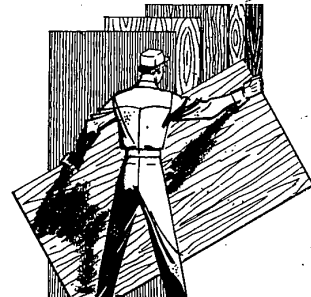

U.S. Balance Of Payments Shows Surplus

WASHINGTON -- President Johnson's crash program on inflation, which was initiated last January, seems to be working since the U.S. balance of payments figure is lower than it has been in more than three years.
The \$35 million surplus follows a second-quarter deficit of \$160 million and a first-quarter deficit of \$680 million.
The balance of payment compares what Americans and their government spend or lend in dealings with foreign individuals or governments, and how much others invest or spend in the United States.

ANN ARBOR -- Members of the University Local 1583 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees agreed on a contract with University of Michigan officials after 49 negotiating sessions.
The contract will remain in effect until December of 1970, and calls for a pay raise of \$1.82 to \$2 per hour, effective Nov. 24. Shift premiums for night work have been increased. The university service and maintenance employees also gained increased health insurance premiums and two additional paid holidays per year.

LANSING -- Gov. George Romney and Shiga Gov. Kinichiro Nozaki signed the agreement which would make Shiga, Japan and Michigan, U.S.A. sister states.
The two exchanged gifts before the formal ceremonies at MSU, and both said the other's flag would sit in their offices. "The future of the world hinges importantly on a good basis of friendship between the people of the United States and the people of Japan," Romney told a luncheon crowd after the formal agreement.

WASHINGTON -- The nation's bishops said that couples will not be cut off from communion or turned away from the church for breaking Pope Paul VI's ban on all artificial birth control.
The Catholic leaders stressed their support for the Pope's encyclical on birth control, but they suggest certain circumstances can reduce the moral wrong, as the church views it, of disobeying the ban.

News Round Up

SPACE CENTER, HOUSTON -- America's Apollo 8 moon-flight crew said their Christmas voyage in lunar orbit will be a simple mission, and will pave the way to lessen the risks for a U.S. moon landing next year.
The mission, which will carry the three astronauts around the moon 10 times on Christmas eve, is scheduled to start its half-million-mile flight to the moon on Dec. 21 and drop into the Pacific Ocean a week later.

PHILADELPHIA -- More than 175 women and children were ousted and 12 were arrested as they staged a "sit-in" demanding a \$50-per-person Christmas grant for "faded" recipients.
The demonstrators, more than half of them children, were removed from the state office building with little trouble by state troopers equipped with helmets and riot sticks. The women had vowed to stay in the building "until Christmas if necessary."

CLEVELAND -- Cleveland's zoo got a surprise addition last week when Big Red gave birth to a 30-pound hippopotamus. "Big Red seemed a little bit irritated, but that is quite normal for her," Charles Voracek, the zoo's public service director said of the surprise arrival's mother.

LANSING -- The Michigan State Medical Society stepped up its campaign for legislative funding of a full four-year medical school at Michigan State University.
At the meeting Dr. Kenneth R. Johnson, secretary of MSMS, said that MSU is already half-way toward its goal of a full, four-year, degree-granting, medical school with about \$30 million invested in its current two-year program.

WASHINGTON -- Mark Hatfield, Oregon's Republican senator, said he plans to revive efforts to replace the draft with an all-volunteer Army in a move that would implement a Nixon campaign proposal.
Hatfield said his bill will call for a prompt start on the changeover. Nixon proposed to wait until the end of the Vietnam war.

Congressional experts predict that the proposal will run into the same stiff opposition it has encountered in past confrontations with the powerful armed services committees of both houses of Congress.

LANSING -- Michigan's 1969 license plates, which are now on sale, will be based on 50 cents per hundred pounds of vehicle compared with last year's 35 cents per hundred pounds.
The weight tax on the red plates with white numerals was increased during the extra session of 1967 as part of a "good roads" package of bills.

LANSING -- State Sen. James G. Fleming, R-Jackson, has protested the federal government's new federal land restrictions which will force a cutback in Michigan road building plans next year.

Fleming said that the state Highway Department will have to pare contracts amounting to \$38 million down to \$6 million as a result of the new bill.
Legislatures throughout the country are planning to bring "every available pressure to bear upon the federal government," Fleming said.

LIVONIA -- An effort is being made by an agency called Uni-List to locate Negro families in Detroit suburbs, including Livonia. The group is working with black real estate brokers and the Northwest Community Organization. The latter body is headed by the Detroit Archdiocese.
