Michigan Art Ehibition Rules

The 57th Exhibition for Michigan Artists will be held at the Detroit Institute of Arts from Jan, 15 through Feb. 23, 1969. In amounting the dates of the blennial show, Samuel Wagnistf, the museum's curred or Contemporary Art, stated that the entry procedure this year would adopt the practice of many other large regional and national competitions, Artists will be requested to submit 2"x2" color sildes of their entries rather than delivering the actual work to the museum, "Entries for the last Michigan Artists, show exceeded 1,700 tiems, An even larger

igan Artists, show exceeded 1,700 items. An even larger number can be expected for the coming exhibition," Wagstaff said, "Slides of entries should

be a convenience for the artists, eliminating shipping problems and expense on large, heavy or fragite items, And the slides will simplify the inuseum's limitations of space and personnel for handling and storing the objects. These are the considerations that favored the new format."
