

# Plymouth Symphony Adds State Composer's Work

A work not on the earlier schedule has been added to the Plymouth Symphony's program this week.

The work is "Variations on a Theme of Monteverdi" by Walter Wynn York, a member of the Olivet College faculty. The Plymouth Symphony will present its second free concert of the season Sunday, Nov. 24, at 4 p.m. in the Plymouth High School gym, Main at Church streets.

Solist will be soprano Roma Riddell.

York's own program notes on the 10 variations describe them variously as "like the steps of a graceful but unburied dance; determined; capricious; a somewhat masculine vivacity; quiet but warm-hearted; a gentle jocosity; sombre and introspective with perhaps a certain sub-tropical sensuality; murderous and triumphant."

The composer is familiar to Plymouth audiences. The symphony performed his "Rosa-baga Suite," based on Carl Sandburg's children's classic,

at last year's family concert.

MISS RIDDELL will be heard with the orchestra in Mahler's "Songs of a Wayfarer" and Tchaikovsky's "Adieu, Forests" from "Jeune d'Arc."

An exponent of contemporary music, she has won a great deal of critical praise in Canada, where she has spent much of her career.

Miss Riddell has been a leading soprano with the Toronto Opera Festival Company and the CBC Opera Company, recently she completed a three-

week engagement singing the lead in "Sound of Music" with the Kingsmen Club of St. John's, Newfoundland.

THE ORCHESTRA, conducted by Wayne Danlop, will be heard in Rossini's Overture to "Tancredi" and Vaughan Williams' Symphony No. 2 ("A London Symphony").

Rossini, best known for "Wil-

liam Tell," wrote "Tancredi," his first successful opera, in 1813. Based on a Voltaire drama, the opera was full of patriotic sentiments and martial passages.
