

Three Injured In Accident

Three persons were injured in a four-car accident at Farmington Road and Seven Mile in Livonia, according to Livonia police.

James A. Swindlehurst, 27, of 24311 McCauley, Farmington, was taken by ambulance to St. Mary Hospital in Livonia for treatment following the accident.

A driver and passenger in one of the cars he hit were taken to Redford Community Hospital for treatment. They were John Robert Kennedy, 23, of Harper Woods and his passenger, Eva L. Fireston, of 19450 Rensselaer, Livonia.

Livonia police estimated Swindlehurst's speed at 65 miles per hour when the first of four collisions occurred.

According to the accident report, Swindlehurst, driving north on Farmington Road, clipped the rear of a sedan turning left onto eastbound Seven Mile. The driver, Neil F. Lawrence, 22, of Grosse Pointe Woods and his passenger both were unhurt.

The report said that Swindlehurst's car went off the roadway on the right side of Farmington Road north of Seven Mile, striking a parked car owned by James Odette of 14477 Park, Livonia. No one was in the car, a station wagon, which was completely turned around by the impact.

Continuing forward, Swindlehurst's car smashed into the side of the sedan, occupied by

Kennedy and his passenger as they prepared to drive onto Farmington Road, according to police. The impact carried Kennedy's car onto the road.

Police said Swindlehurst's car went a few feet more, clipping a second unoccupied parked car. This one was a sedan owned by David Poggione of Warren.
