out, because Sara Houchins and Clara Seymour will be consistently strong," coach Jeff Dwyer said.

"All those girls are capable of getting a 9 on each event. We just have a lot of girls. There's still a lot potential here."

"After we lost to (Rochester) Adams, we realized we'd have to pick up a few more tricks. It's difficult, but the girls have been working on that, and they're just starting to throw those in routines now."

Farmington, which has scored consistently in the 142 to 144 range, looked especially good Jan. 4 when it won its event and the Plymouth Salem Invitational.

"That was a nice surprise," Dwyer said. "It was kinda neat

because I was able to throw an additional team, and they took fifth place in two events."

"I'm real fortunate. I have 12 girls who are very strong gymnasts, and it was just to see two of our teams up there getting awards in two events."

"It was a good way to start the year. We went against Brighton and Hartland, and those are two of the teams in our regional. It was early in the season, but it was nice to get a win."

Farmington is idle until Jan. 23 when it hosts Troy Athens in another dual meet.

The Farmington Invitational will follow on Saturday, Jan. 25.

Dwyer's team is looking forward to a continued strong showing in February, leading up to the Oakland Activities Association and regional meets.

"We still have a lot of experience from the last couple years."

Dwyer said. "They know what it takes now. They're going after the things they need to go after if we're going to be one of the top teams in the state."

"I'm just sitting back and enjoying it all. It's a great team; they're a great bunch of girls to coach."

Farmington lost its second straight OAA Division I match Monday to visiting Clarkston, 16-14, 2-15, 2-15.

The Falcons are 1-3 in the division - all three losses occurring on their home court - and 10-8-1 overall.

Farmington overcame an 8-13 deficit in the first game with a nice comeback, but Clarkston dominated the next two games.

"We're just not playing good defense," Falcons coach Alex Perrin said. "The Wolves are a good team; I'm not taking anything away from them. We're just a bad defensive team right now."

Last year we were embarrassed and turned it into a positive. Now we're embarrassed and we have to see what this team is going to do about that. Right now we're just embarrassed."

Jill Alspach and Jessica Janowicz have five kills apiece and Deanna Gauer four. As a team, the Falcons had no kills in the second game.

Setter Lisa Hellebuich had 13 assists, four digs and six service points with one ace; Maria Marafiotis had nine digs and Gauer four, and Rachel Heinrich had two solo blocks.

"It doesn't take much to cause us to make a bad pass," Perrin said, adding the team has too many breakdowns. "All six players need to play defense and right now we don't have six playing."

"As a team, we have to decide if we're going to make those plays or have results like this. It's not a matter of winning games but being respectfully competitive. Right now we're not."

"We either take it as a wake-up call, or we'll be sleeping through the whole season."
