**Let Others Have Their Say**  
The art of effective listening is a skill that type of all have mastered. When listening to others, we are often so concerned about what we will say next that we fail to hear what the other person is saying. A conversation is a two-sided street that should go both ways and form like a good round church, if one side is dominating the conversation or not having it won't be a good conversation. Although it's not to deny people with our speaking left and right ears, we often listen just want someone to listen to them in their own words, they may need to vent their feelings and they aren't necessarily asking us to solve their problems or even give them feedback, just that they want someone to listen to them and hear them out. The next time you are in a conversation, try to be a good listener.
