

Tri-Farmington wins final dual meet

Tri-Farmington finished its dual-meet gymnastics season Tuesday with a 138.3-129.95 victory over host Troy, giving Tri-Farmington a final record of 7-3.

"Tri-Farmington had lost its previous two meets to top-ranked Rochester Adams and Troy Athens.

Coach Dwyer's team had one of its best scores in the Adams meet, 145.85, but the host Highlanders, who beat Tri-Farmington twice, had a 148.4.

"They're just loaded," Dwyer said. "They're not unbeatable, but they're certainly ranked No. 1 for a reason."

Tri-Farmington didn't have its regular lineup for the Athens meet due to injuries and the absence of some gymnasts, who were at a club meet in Florida.

"We opened the door by falling on beams," Dwyer said. "They stuck beam and that was enough to hold us off on floor."

The next competition is the Oakland Activities Association meet on Thursday, which starts at 6:30 p.m. at Adams High School. The regional is in St. Petersburg, Fla.

"We want to be peaking in the next two weeks," Dwyer said, adding his team is trying to get healthy for those meets.

"We didn't throw everyone on every event in the Troy meet. We have the conference coming up, and we're just trying to

save our bodies.

"Part one is the dual-meet season, and this is where the real excitement comes in as a team. Our goal is to be one of the top teams in the state.

"We can't worry about how good Adams is or Grand Ledger is. If we can get the team to go all out and not be afraid of the state meet, I think our odds are good."

Dwyer added the team's goal is to earn a trophy at the state meet. The top two teams receive one.

"Third is nice, but you don't bring anything home," he said. "Right now I'm looking for effort from the team, and we'll see what happens."
