A Good Tip

You will rarely regret leaving a fair and generous tip to someone for a task done well. But if you give someone a small tip or no tip at all, you may feel bad about it afterwards. Giving a good tip makes the person who served you feel appreciated. In some settings, such as restaurants, the server may actually depend on tips as part of their income. But only if you tip them. Tipping makes the server feel good. It makes the server feel like they have done the right thing. The Bible tells us that God will always make us rich enough to be generous at all times, so that many will thank God for the gifts which they receive from us. (1 Timothy 4:11) A friend once asked his father some advice on tipping. Should he, for instance, tip the waiter, the newspaper boy or girl, or the mechanic? His father - who was a notoriously good tipper - told him that he should not be too surprised, since a tip is a thank you gift for a job well done. Who doesn't like to be told that they have done a good job, and to receive a gift that they can use anyway they please? Tipping is a good way to show our appreciation to someone who has done us a good service.
