"I generally sell what I like myself," Hemmer said. "I look for aesthetics, and see if it is useful as well as beautiful."

Hemmer enjoyed the show last year, which was her first appearance there, so she's returned. "They have pretty

much everything from A to Z there. There's lots of small items, china and giftware from the '30s, '40s and '50s, and good oak furniture."
