cal education classes for OLS students.

Also this fall, a pilot program will be launched to bring in 20 out-of-district students at William Grace and Flanders Elementary Schools, who will bring their state foundation allowance with them.

More than 70 teachers took advantage of an early retirement incentive last year, minimizing layoffs for first-year

teachers. Dollars were saved with the salary differential between experienced teachers and their replacements.

A partnership with the Oakland Intermediate School district, where regional staff development services are provided at the Farmington Training Center, provides another source of revenue.

District officials are committed to phasing out its warehouse operation, which promises more savings.

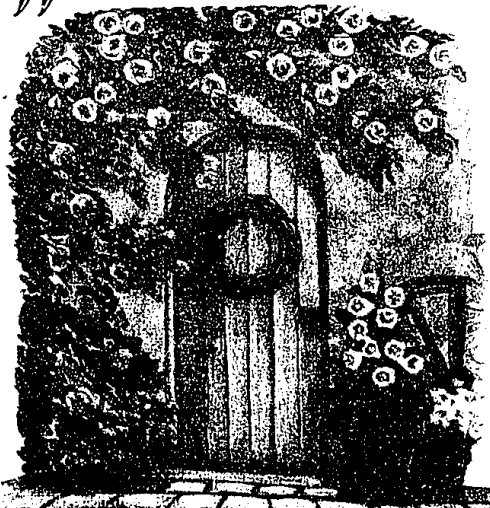
Cost savings were realized when the Gill Year Round pro-

gram ended and officials designated Fairview and Alameda as Early Childhood Centers, moving school-age children back to their home schools.

"The district is particularly proud of the results of the human resource department's careful management of benefit costs," according to information provided in Just For Parents, a school newsletter. "In health insurance alone, the district has saved \$6.5 million in recent years."
