School board candidates spar over moving meetings

June 9. Candidate John Goshorn, a commercial business manager for Ford, brought the idea for-ward during his last board bid, in 2001. Candidate Karen Boisen, who co-chairs the Farmington/Farmington Hills Multiracial Multicultural Community Council and has a consulting business, complained the idea isn't fiscally responsible. She projected the cost at \$700 a resting.

Goshorn has recommended using students and volunteers to coordinate the events.

"Everyone feels good alout themselves and they know they can achieve the goals," Swaim said. 
