She started asking around, and an original group of eight women began meeting at Big Boy's in July of last year. Today 178 moms claims membership in the group, with soms and daughters in all five military branches.

A tot of people try to understand what we go through; asid Peg Krueger, a Michigan Military Moms member from Canton, "but these people real-

ly understand because they're in the same situation." Michigan Military Moms, she said, was an important source of support while her son David was fighting along side fellow Marines in Iraq. "He saw a lot of action," she said, "but they fought hard and fought well." As of last week, David was safe buck in the States - and hir mom can breathe a little easier. Michigan Military Moms meets the second and fourth Thursday of each month at the American Legion Hall in Dearborn.
