One of the problems that often occurs in streetlife photography is confusing and busy backgrounds.

Try to avoid this by choosing a camera position that isolates your subject from the surroundings. Use a telephoto lens to frame your picture tightly and by using a wide aperture, distractions in the hackground will be kept out of focus.

The possibilities for streetlife photography are endless. This is a shot Monte Hagler took in Cambodia. This interesting woman is a caretaker for the Buddha.

To minimize problems with To minimize problems with contrast, photograph subjects that are out of direct smilight. Better still, an overcast day provides the best lighting for streetlife people pictures. Bright colors are more saturated and lighting on faces is more flattering.
Use a fast film in the 400ASA range either color or black and white depending

on your preference.
The faster films will enable you to hand hold exposures under most circum-

stances.
So there you have it. Become streetwise with streetlife.
