artery in the groin up to the heart. Cardiac Calcium Scoring helps doctors calculate your risk of heart attack. The scan is also non-invasive and clearly deplete early plaque buildup in the arteries.

### LESS TIME

Images of the lungs, head, heart, abdomen and pelvis can be viewed immediately in two and three dimensions, allowing doctors to 'literally drive through a patient's body, looking for unexpected bumps in the road - polyps or growths that cannot be detected.' The virtual colonoscopy doesn't eliminate the need for a traditional procedure if something questionable is found during the exam. Fenton said then a patient is referred back to his or her physician who schedules the traditional colonoscopy.
