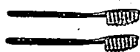

WOULD ALLOW BETTING Michigan will join the ranks of those states of the union which legally recognize betting on horse racing, if the legislature passes a measure which was introduced in the House the latter part of the week.

The commissioner of agriculture would issue one license for each county of the State, save Wayne County, which would be entitled to two tracks.

Under the pari-mutual and certificate plans of placing wagers on horse races, the State would

take a certain fixed percentage of all moneys wagered. Licenses also would be a large source of income for the State, for the fee would be \$1,000 for each 60 days. Large fees for daily heats, depending on the length of the tracks, would also be levied.

Safety means saving human life.

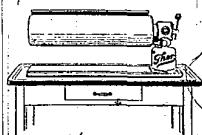
Obeying the simple rules of safety cut down the number of accidents in industry in this state last year nearly one-third.
