Relative to Opening and Closing of the Polls

Public Acts 1929—No. 306—Chapter VIII.

Section 1. On the day of any election the polls shall be opened at seven o'clock in the forenoon and shall be continued open until six o'clock in the afternoon and no longer: PROVIDED, That in townships the board of inspectors of election may, in its discretion, adjourn the polls at twelve o'clock, for one hour, and that the township board in townships and the legislative body in cities and villages may, by resolution, provide that the polls shall be opened at six o'clock in the forenoon and shall be kept open not later than eight o'clock in the evening of the same day. Every qualified elector present and in line at the polls at the hour prescribed for the closing thereof shall be allowed to vote.

THE POLLS of said election will be open at 7 o'clock a. m., and will remain open until 8 o'clock p. m. Central Standard Time, of said day of election, unless the Board of Inspectors of Election, given to their discretion, adjourn the Polls at 12 o'clock, noon, for one hour.

Where Eastern Standard Time is adopted such time shall govern all elections.

Provision in Case of Removal to Another Precinct

Sec. II—Part II—Chap. III. Any registered and qualified voter who has removed from one election precinct of a township to another election precinct of the same township shall have the right, on any day previous to election, or primary election day, to have his or her name transferred from the registration book of the precinct in which he or she has removed to the registration book of the precinct in which he or she then resides. Such elector shall have the right to have such transfer made on any election or primary election day by obtaining from the board of inspectors of such election or primary election of the precinct from

which he or she has removed a Certificate of Transfer and presenting the said certificate to the Board of Election Inspectors of the Precinct in which he or she then resides.
