



Again to be added to this is 6% interest on all deferred payments on the Nine Mile road which would add several thousand dollars more to the above sum. This does not take into consideration outstanding bonds on Covert roads in the Township built heretofore. With the large debt before us, which has been growing for years, and the taking on of an additional debt in the past year of over \$100,000, including assessment district of Nine-Mile road, and with prospects of less percentage of tax being collected this year than ever before, has been the cause of much talk and a great alarm as to what is going to be the future of the Township. The question is wholly up to the voters at the primary on March 2 whether we put our mark of approval on the policy of our present of fice-holders and encourage them in increasing our indebtedness as has been done in the past year or whether we check some of what seems to be unnecessary expenditures of money by putting in officers who will at least try to put some stop to the present policy.
