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## STATE POLICE TRAINED IN BELL SYSTEM FIRST AID

The State of Pennsylvania recently enlisted the services of the Bell Telephone Company of Pennsylvania in the training of candidates for the State Highway Patrol. It is the task of these patrolmen to enforce the laws, to handle traffic, and to endeavor to eliminate accidents.

One of the first lessons that a Pennsylvania patrolman learns in the Training School, which he must attend and from which he must be graduated before he can qualify for highway service, is that he should at all times extend every courtesy and assistance to the motoring public. He undergoes a most rigid and systematic course of instruction, and it was in this branch of the training that the telephone company's service was enlisted for a specially prepared three months course in First Aid.

The regular Bell System First Aid Training Course was adapted to the use of the student patrolmen, for it has been found that in the course of their duties along the Pennsylvania highway, a thorough knowledge of First Aid is indispensable. The State authorities felt that the telephone company was in a better position to help with this instruction than any other agency available.

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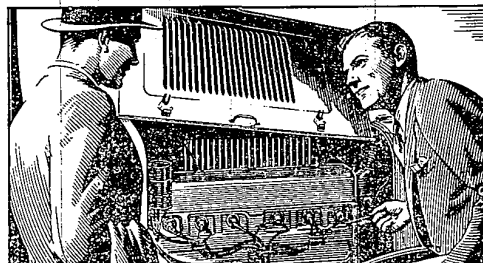
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
