## Writer Visions A World Apart—Matters Of The Soul Have No Part

A Message from Zarma, Resident of the Planet Ata.

From the corner of my library at midnight came a voice, a voice of wondrous quality: "Do not be alarmed," it said. Strange to say I was not. I laid aside my treatise on the subconscious mind and addressed my visitor.

"Who are you, and where are you?" I asked.

"My name is Zarma," the voice replied, "and I am one hundred thousand light years distant on the planet Ata, that revolves about a sun not yet discovered by your astronomers, a planet closely resembling your own but several million years older, and upon which human life exists many eons more advanced in civilization than yours upon the earth."

"I am a scientist, a teacher employing scientific methods, methods that require that all statements be subject to verification by the experience and experiments of other competent observers," I replied. "Can you give me any proof of your amazing statements?"

"I can and I shall," he said. "Our scientists have learned to disintegrate, project and reassemble objects and can, by this means and the aid of certain rays, transport an object to your earth. By the use of another ray we can see you, hear you and talk to you and we have transported to your library a cabinet that contains a mechanism by means of which you may see us and converse with us."

The corner of the room from which the voice emanated was dark. I arose and switched on the overhead lights and saw between the north window and the corner of the book case, a beautiful cabinet, the front of which was composed of a material resembling frosted glass. As I looked, a picture in color formed upon it, the picture of a world much like our own as I imagine it might appear from the height of a hundred miles or so. I had the sensation of approaching it, a constantly diminishing portion appearing in ever greater detail until I seemed to be within a beautiful garden, and there seated before me was a man.

He was like a man of our world transfigured, glorified. His body was perfectly developed, suffused with the glow of health. His brow was noble, the eyes, infinitely wise and kind and his countenance seemed to radiate beauty. I can best describe as spiritual. Scepticism, curiosity and wonder had in turn possessed me and, now came reverence for a personality that I instinctively recognized as the finest and most wonderful I had ever known.

Strange, he was bringing his world and himself to me but it seemed as though I was sitting opposite to him in his garden.

"As you have surmised, I am Zarma," he said.

When I had to some extent recovered my composure, I said a strange thing. "Zarma! I want to be your friend and live in your world."

Zarma did not seem to think it strange. "I am your friend," he said, "and we can live in either world or both. Through you I shall give a message to our fellowmen upon the earth."

"For ten thousand years we have known you. We know your history, your languages, thoughts and ideals. You have suffered much avoidable misery but not until now has there been any possibility of our helping you, much as our hearts have yearned to do so."

"You have not been spiritually self conscious. You have blindfolded the spiritual eyes and stopped the spiritual ears of your children, even as your parents did to you. You have taught them that it was the will of God or Gods of the Goddess of Reason that they remain throughout their earth life so blinded and deafened. Light filtered through, sound penetrated. You either believed that that was all the light and sound you could receive or that you must wait for death to remove all barriers."

"You and your children have inherited or been taught, within and without your homes, of the visions of individual men as truths. Clear apprehension by

their own spiritual senses or faculties and the development of their spiritual qualities has been suppressed, aborted, retarded and inhibited by this feeling of obligation to accept the spiritual world through the medium of another's personality. They are likewise affected by the reign of superstition, creeds, customs, dogma, inbred and acquired inertia, and, most vitally important, by their acceptance of the infallibility of human reason, when guided by the correct logical rules, to determine the nature of truth on all planes of existence. This results in a failure to clearly realize the predominant part played in their lives and all life and existence by their fundamental spiritual nature, and the recognition that their own spirit, soul or ultimate self, has a separate, valid and adequate equipment for contact with and absorption of the facts of the spiritual environment. The intellect is a wonderful instrument or tool of the self for dealing with the outer world, but the tool does not plan the work it accomplishes.

"Reason is a tool for shaping things and people on the material plane. You use your physical senses. You are self conscious physically and mentally, but you do not use your spiritual faculties to deal with things and people on the spiritual plane and you are, therefore, not spiritually self conscious."

"Love and faith and all the spiritual qualities are inherent in your being. They have no object. They are the most vital and potent forces of the eternal life and grow in breadth and strength in each of us as we share them with our fellows, and open up all doors of our threefold nature to their benign influence."

"From their source they penetrate all life, and all suffering comes from but the one cause, a narrowing or blocking of any of the channels, through which it is their nature to freely flow into and out of our souls from others and to others."

"Have more and more faith. Do not attempt to define it or seek an object of it. Be more and more love. Know no self limitation of the soul. The mind seeks knowledge, the spirit more abundant being. Do not be afraid to see what you may see or hear what you may hear with the eyes and ears of the soul. Do not fear to become in spirit one with all spirit. The mind can know no God, spirit. The soul as it lives its life normally, fearlessly, and joyously, will know the truth, in the only way the truth can be known,—by entering therein."

"We have been spiritually self conscious for a million years on Ata. It is a sane and joyous world. We love one another, to the ends of our teaming world, as you love the few you love, as you love and care for you. There is no poverty here and our love for one another has long since inspired us to a successful struggle with disease and preventable accidents. Death is here but it does not bring sorrow. It does not bring separation. Here, life is such that interest and enthusiasm never flag. We do not believe in matter of the soul and the life eternal. We know them as you know the fields and woods, sunshine and your fellowmen, because we live naturally on all planes as you live the very limited life you know on earth. There is nothing strange or other-worldly about it. We lack no worth while value you possess. We have infinitely more. You must forget a lot, stand upon your own spiritual legs, cease feeling other peoples' emotions, cease acting life and know that for every spiritual law there is a law on the material plane that embodies and reflects that law. 'Fellowmen men of earth, concentrate upon this one thought and consecrate your lives upon its realization. Throughout your history the highest ideals and purposes have been clearly expressed but never in your history have faith, love, understanding, tolerance and those other spiritual qualities, to necessary the realization of these ideals and purposes been cultivated and developed to a degree sufficient to make them the predominant emotions, ruling passions and governing motive upon the earth.'"

"Faith cannot grow out of fear, Love cannot grow out of intolerance, greed or malice. Destroy the weeds of your inner gardens. Banish from your hearts and minds the thoughts and emotions that give to your world a thousand conflicting and destructive mot-

ives where the one motive should exist alone, that motive born of love and faith, the creation of the best of all possible worlds upon the earth."

"That, said Zarma, 'is the first message I would have you give to your world. Many will not believe that I or my world exist, but many will know the words I speak are true as soon as they have heard them.'"

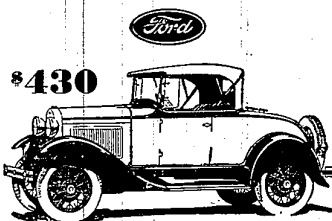
