## Consumer Comment Invited On Paprika

The U.S. Department of Agriculture has extended to Dec. 7 the deadline for filing comments on its proposal to prohibit use of paprika in certain fresh meats and meat products.

The proposal, originally made Oct. 5, would amend federal meat inspection regulations to prohibit use of paprika in fresh meat and fresh meat products except chorizo sausages and Italian types of sausages.

The extension of the original deadline, Nov. 7, was requested by members of the packing industry to permit them more time to evaluate the proposal.

Laboratory tests and other information available to USDA's Consumer and Marketing Service indicate that paprika can mask undesirable color characteristics after the meat has begun to spoil.

C&MS also said tests show that paprika -- a weak-flavored red pepper -- may cause meat to appear leaner than it really is because it produces a reddish coloring of the fat of the meat.




