

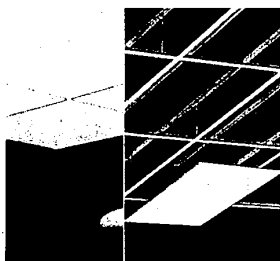

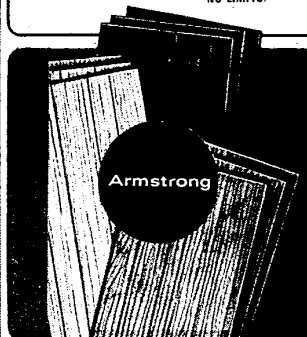

## Ex-Pal Of Leary At SC

Robert Moorman, a former associate of Dr. Timothy Leary and a drug dependent himself for six years, will tell of the horrors of drug abuse at Schoolcraft College on Nov. 9. Moorman's lecture is entitled "Marijuana — Fact or Fantasy." He describes it as a real and clear picture of marijuana and hashish: What they are, what they do, some of their social, legal, physiological, and psychological complications. In 1961 Moorman went to Cambridge, Mass. to begin his college studies. It was there that he was introduced to and started using drugs, back when hippies were called "beatniks." It was not long after he had started college that Moorman "dropped out."

**DURING THE** next six years, Moorman experimented with marijuana (extensive use), morphine and heroin (eight months addiction), LSD and mescaline (four years off and on), amphetamines (five years off and on), solvents and glues (limited use), romalor (limited use), barbiturates (limited use), and various assorted pills from time to time. The end of the road for his drug dependence came in 1966 when Moorman was arrested in Tampa, Fla., for grand larceny and possession of narcotics. For 14 months, confined behind the fences of the Florida State and County Prison System, Moorman began a painful, agonizing rehabilitation. For the past two years, Moorman has lectured at high schools, preparatory schools, colleges and universities from coast-to-coast. The lecture will be presented at 8 p.m. in the Waterman Campus Center. It is sponsored by the Cultural Affairs Committee. Admission is \$2 for the general public and \$1 for non-Schoolcraft students.
