A new series of childbirth preparation classes are scheduled to begin in Plymouth shortly.

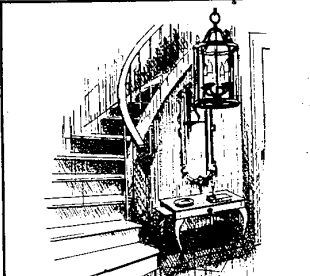
Interested couples should contact Mrs. Alan Woodworth, 171 Blunk, Plymouth, to register.
