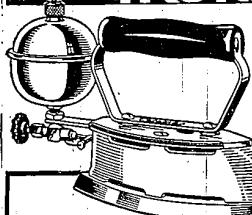

### Red Cross Workers Are Active In Farmington

Farmington has been one of the most active districts in Oakland County for Red Cross work during the past year. A large amount of flour and clothing has been given out since last fall in a splendid effort to meet the needs of depression-struck citizens.

Relief work is carried on through Mrs. Norman C. Lee, Red Cross director, Mayor, Howard Warner, Commissioner Fred Stams, Supervisor Arthur Coe, and, H. W. Earle.

Women interested in Red Cross work gave their services last winter, repairing old clothes for the use of the poor and doing other sewing. They will see again this fall, and a special effort will be made to furnish clothing for the school children in September.

Red Cross work throughout the county has been extensive this year. Food and clothes valued conservatively at \$125,000 have been distributed to thousands of needy persons in the past year by Oakland County chapter.

Ninety-three thousand two hundred and forty-six garments worth \$50,000 were given.

Twenty-four thousand and seventy-five barrels of flour worth \$75,000 were given.

Food consisted of flour for bread. Red Cross flour was supplied for the entire welfare need of the county from April 20, 1932, up to and including May and a part of June 1933. A total of 24,075 barrels of flour has been procured for the county, resulting in an approximate saving to the governmental welfare agencies of \$75,000.

The grand total of garments distributed is 92,246. Oakland County population is slightly more than 211,000. This comparison does not infer, however, that almost half the county was clothed or needed to be clothed. In many instances more than one garment was required for indigents, either in one distribution or in subsequent distributions. The approximate value of the garments was estimated at \$45,000 to \$50,000.

Of the total delivered to distributing agencies up to April 30, 1933, the number made from yard goods by volunteers was 47,184. The women worked approximately 75,000 hours. The number of factory made garments delivered was 46,062.

The conservatively estimated \$45,000 to \$50,000 valuation represents just that much more saved to welfare agencies of the county.
