or providing an unusual background for searchlights and fireworks.

One curious and unusual artistic effect that Raymond Hood probably never dreamed of has resulted. As you stand between the great green towers and look out towards the blue sky over the lake in the early evening you will be surprised to find that the sky is no longer blue; it has turned into a most gorgeous hue of purple-violet.

Nowhere else in the world so far as it is known can a person see a purple-violet sky. This is an optical effect caused by the eyes being flooded with reflected light from the green towers at the same time they are gazing at the blue sky. The combination of the green and blue rays on the retina of the eye causes the brain to perceive this most gorgeous purple-violet hue.

Also, as a final touch, during the hot days of summer the Court of Communications was the coolest place on the whole. For grounds. No matter from what direction a cooling breeze came, one of the towers, with its interior fluted columns caught the air, carried it down to the base and swirled it around the seats about the pool. Many a foot-weary Ulysses on his Odyssey through the miles of World's Fair buildings has sunk with a sigh of contentment into a seat beside the quiet pool and imagined that at last he had come to the cool cave home of Aeolus, the mythological Greek God of the Winds. Salt, Other Chemicals

Very Toxic to Swine

To the veterinarian it is well known that salt and certain other chemicals are very toxic to swine under certain conditions. Some of these conditions can be traced to unsuitable compounds, especially when force fed. Moreover, such preparations are rarely necessary, especially where pigs have been farrowed in clean quarters, allowed free range of pasture and fed a well-balanced ration. It is well known that a sudden change of feed, especially one of an irritating nature following the administration of serum and virus will often produce a serious or fatal acute enteritis.

In certain sections of the country there are no doubt poisonous plants that cause considerable trouble, and in some cases a high mortality.

Rickets, anthraxis, paralysis and similar conditions, can be prevented by proper feeding and care, and can be corrected by the administration of calcium and iodine in proper amounts. Paralysis of breeding sows is thought to be caused by an improper ration, and can usually be cured by the administration of iodine in some suitable form. So-called milk fever in sows affects plethoric animals, especially if the quarters permit of little exercise and easy access to feed.

Longest Mountain Range

The Rocky mountains, stretching to Alaska, form the longest range in the world. The highest peak of this range in the United States is Mt. Elbert in Colorado, 14,420 feet, while the highest peak in the whole system is Mt. McKinley in Alaska, 29,300 feet. The tallest of the Canadian Rockies is Mt. Robson in British Columbia, 12,973 feet. Pike's Peak is 14,131 feet.

Timothy Blooms at Night

Timothy blooms first come out of the "bud" between midnight and two o'clock in the morning. The bloom may be pink or yellow at that time and purple by morning.

Feeding Milk to Calves

Calves, according to the best authorities, should have new milk or whole milk until they are from two to four weeks of age; after that it is advisable—almost necessary—that they have skim milk until they are three months old. It can then be discontinued if the calves are consuming a good grain ration and getting a good grade of legume hay. Should one not have enough skim milk for at least ten pounds daily per calf, it would be advisable to secure some skim milk powder.

Lamb Crop Smaller

The estimated 1933 lamb crop of 28,998,000 head for the United States was about 2 1/2 per cent or 100,000 head smaller than the 1932 crop and over 5,000,000 head smaller than the record crop of 1931. Nearly all of the decrease this year occurred in the Western sheep states, the crop in the native sheep states being almost as large as last year. The native lamb crop this year is estimated at 10,947,000 head.

Profit by Hog Sanitation

Hog growers in Indiana who are using the swine sanitation system developed by the United States Department of Agriculture are now saving an average of more than eight pigs per litter. The same farmers saved only five to six pigs per litter before they adopted this method. The sanitation system consists essentially in washing sows thoroughly, especially around the udders, before they farrow, having them farrow in clean quarters, and keeping the pigs on clean pastures.
